

## Conditions of Media Accreditation

### Purpose

Accreditation for the 2018 Gold Coast Schoolies Community Safety Response is to support the role of media, stakeholders and support services in the communication of public information and important community messages.

Applicants approved for media accreditation will receive email media alerts; escorted access into the Schoolies Hub and Wristband Distribution Centre at designated times; and, a media pass for identification in the Surfers Paradise precinct.

### Conditions

1. The media pass must be worn whilst performing professional duties in the Surfers Paradise precinct during the Gold Coast Schoolies Community Safety Response.
2. The media pass is not transferable.
3. The issuer reserves the right to revoke media accreditation at any time.
4. Access into the Schoolies Hub and stage is only permitted at a designated time and under escort by Schoolies officials. A media tabard will be provided and must be worn at all times whilst in the Schoolies Hub for identification purposes.
5. A maximum of three personnel from the one organisation will be permitted access into the Schoolies Hub on any one night.
6. Stakeholders and Support Services must submit supporting documentation in advance of the Gold Coast Schoolies Community Safety Response for access into the Schoolies Hub. This supporting documentation must outline the dates access is required, for what purpose and how content will be used.
7. There is to be no filming or photography directly in front of Schoolies Hub entry points.
8. There is no access into the 'mosh pit' or 'back-of-house' areas within the Schoolies Hub.
9. In the event of an emergency, accredited media must follow directions of emergency services or official staff at all times.
